1. COMPETITION SCHEDULE

2. Wild Card

For the Japan Beach Volleyball Tour, the quota of wild cards allocated to each tournament is as follows:

Tournament	Maximum number of Wild Card Per Gender
Grand Slam	Two (2) decided by JVA
Open	Main Draw: Two (2) decided by JVA QT (if applicable): Two (2) decided by JVA

- Maximum 2 teams per gender will be able to participate in each event as Wild Card.
- In principle, Wild Card allocations are at the discretion of JVA. JVA will take into consideration the promotional aspects, technical merits, athletes' career, satisfactory technical/status of the team, etc. to select the teams.
- Wild cards are announced through the confirmed entry list issued by JVA for Tour tournament concerned, however, in certain instances, JVA may notify participating teams in advance to confirm their travel arrangement.
- The Wild Card is not transferrable if there is a disbanding of the team or withdrawal of the team. However, considering 'force majeure' or injury of one or both athletes, as exception, the Wild Card may be transferred at JVA's discretion due to the new team' merits.
- There is no maximum number of wild card that an athlete can receive during one season.

3. Uniforms

Athletes must bring at least 2 colors of uniforms, otherwise athletes cannot participate in each tournament.

4. Entry Fee

5,000JPY per athlete is paid onsite. Only cash is available.

○ Entry Procedure

Athletes who wish to participate in the events send followings to the event organizer at japantour@jva.or.jp by respective entry deadline.

- First name & last name (both players)
- FIVB# (both players)
- Height & Weight (both players)
- Event name (if more than two, please clarify your priority)

After the deadline, the organizer will select the teams and email all teams the result. In order to confirm the participation, JVA will send invitation letter to his/her NF and receive a declaration from his/her NF.

○ Visa & Entry Documents

Participants are responsible for organizing their own Visa to enter Japan if necessary.

6. COMPETITION

○ Preliminary Inquiry

No preliminary inquiry for all events is scheduled so far.

○ Technical Meeting

No technical meeting for all events is schedule so far.

(*) A foreign athlete is not required to attend the preliminary inquiry and technical meeting even if it is organized since it is conducted by only Japanese. The organizer will help and to inform foreign athletes of the necessary information shared in the preliminary inquiry and technical meeting.

- Training Principles & Availability

Official training will be basically secured for all participating teams 1 day before the event.

1 hour (or less minutes depending on the courts availability) slot will be allocated for 1 team, but 2 spots booking may be possible if 2 teams train together.

The Organizer will ask in advance all teams by email to hear the preference of a training time.

- Official Ball

The official balls are the "MIKASA" BV550C-WYBR and the "MOLTEN" V5B5000.

MIKASA BV550C-WYBR is used for men and MOLTEN V5B5000 is used for women.

7. EVENT SITE INFORMATION

- Competition Venue

Please refer to the EVENT SCHEDULE.

- Accreditation

Official accreditation will be provided to all athletes by the organizer and will ensure that only those with appropriate accreditation can access the designated venue areas.

Please note that accreditation cards will be returned to the organizer at the end of each tournament.

- Accommodation and Transportation

Athletes will be personally responsible for international flight, domestic transportation, hotel and meals.

- Mixed Zone, Press Conferences and Awarding Ceremony

Athletes are required to attend mixed zone interviews, press conference (if organized) and awarding ceremony. Athletes are required to wear their competition uniform.

○ Uniforms

As previously mentioned above, playing tops/tanks will **NOT** be provided to all athletes by the organizer.

If required by the organizer, playing tops/tanks, shorts/bottom and accessories will be checked before the match. Athletes of the same team must wear the same color and style of shorts.
